On behalf of the Santo Nino Council I would like to congratulate Fr. Danilo Rafael and the parishioners of St. Mary's Parish, here in Regina, as they celebrate their 125th Anniversary. In 1883 the Parish of

Saint Mary's was established with a small church on the 1800 block of Cornwall Street. The Parish was entrusted to the Oblates of Mary Immaculate and was part of the Diocese of Saint Boniface. The Archdiocese of Regina was not established until 1910.

As the Catholic population grew the little church was inadequate in Regina and so in 1905 the nave of the present Blessed Sacrament Church was built. The transept was added in 1913. The parish was still called Saint Mary's and was still served by the Oblates of Mary Immacu-

Then in 1934, Archbishop James McGuigan of Regina, who later became Cardinal McGuigan in Toronto, asked the Oblates to establish a new parish on the 2000 block of Winnipeg Street. The Oblates took the name Saint Mary's with them and from 1934 on the original Saint Mary's became known as Blessed Sacrament, and Blessed Sacrament has been served by Diocesan priests since 1934.

I think you will agree with me that the 125th Anniversary of Saint Mary's Parish is very significant for our Council because while our Council is centred at Blessed Sacrament, we now include a large number of what was Msgr. Jansenn (Please continue to p. 3)



OUR LADY OF PENAFRANCIA AT ST. MARY'S

On August 9, 2008 the statue of our Lady of Penafrancia (called INA by her devotees), patroness of Bikolandia in the Philippines was enshrined at St. Mary's Church at a Mass presided by Fr. Raymundo R. Rodriguez with Frs. Infante, Rafael, Tamayo and Tubale as concelebrants.

The enshrinement was made possible through the efforts of Dr. Cyril Llaneta, Drs. Art and Joyce Magnaye and PGK James and Fannie Madrilejos. After the Mass, the devotees had a potluck lunch at Wascana Park.

The original image of our Lady of Penafrancia was enshrined in Salamanca, Spain. In Naga City, Philippines, "the devotion to Our Lady of Penafrancia was initiated through the vow of Fr. Miguel de Covarrubias. The public veneration of the image is attested to in Fr. Miguel's letter on May 1, 1710: The image of Our Lady, under the *title of Peña de Francia*, was brought in *solemn procession* to the chapel. And there, she did many *favors to all who made a visit*, and principally *at the Mass on Saturdays*." In 2010, the Archdiocese of Nueva Caceres will be celebrating 300 years of devotion with the theme: "Growing in holiness under the mantle of Ina."

Plans are afoot to have a devotion to INA at St. Mary's every Saturday, 4 - 5 p.m.

May our INA always keep us in her maternal care. VIVA La VIRGEN!
