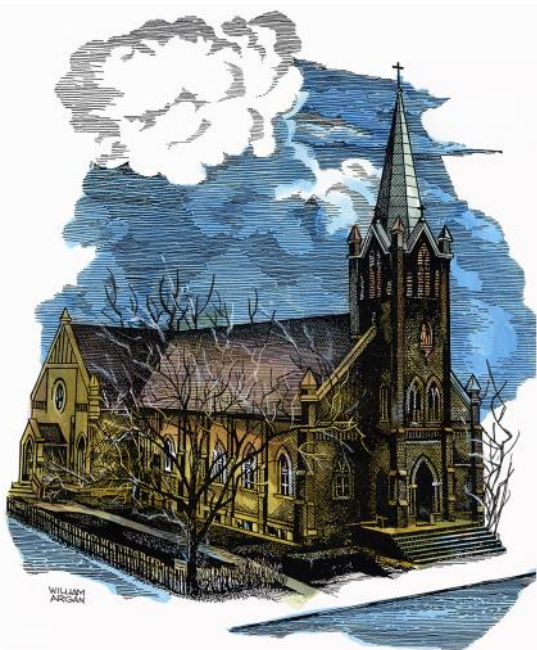

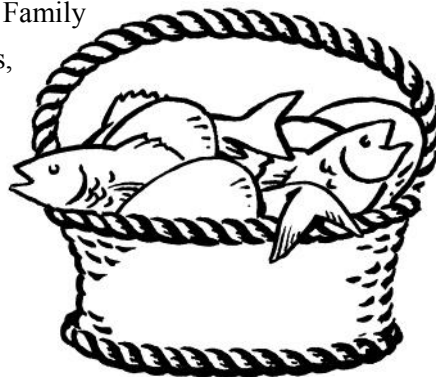
# Ordinary Time - Month of August

**Taste and See the Goodness of the Lord.** In today's Gospel reading, Jesus speaks of the bread of life. Bread is the most basic of foods, a food which sustains human life. The ancient custom of 'breaking bread,' common among all peoples, is a profound mark of hospitality and togetherness: bread, when shared, becomes a symbol of community, of communion with one another. At the Eucharist, bread becomes the body of Christ. This is what we are called to in the Eucharist: to be in communion with one another and to share the bread of life. Christ, that bread of life, "gave himself up for us."

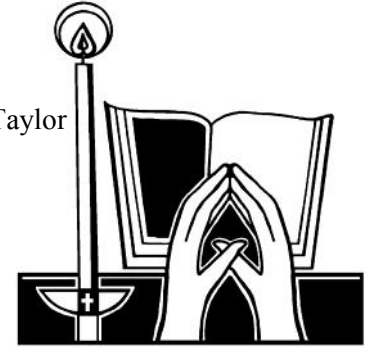
