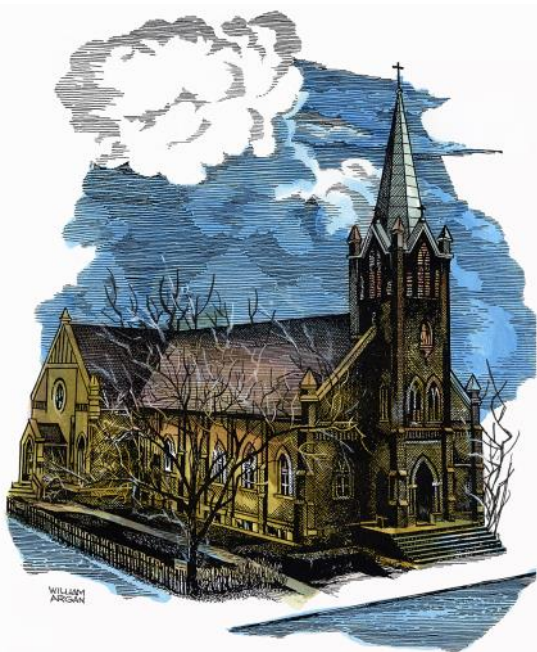

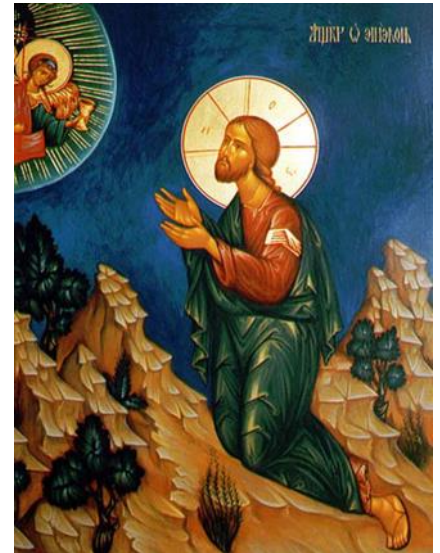

Blessed Sacrament Church Renovations Update 1.0

Boiler Replacement Project: The church and rectory boiler replacement project began on August 14, 2015 with the contract awarded to Reliable Heating & Cooling Ltd. of Regina. A new Dietrick boiler provided heat during the 2014-15 winter season without controls to manage zone temperatures. Fr. Barry made manual adjustments to burner and various valves twice per night for six months.

The new boiler went out of service on May 4, 2015 with a catastrophic leak which we now understand was caused by a manufacturer defect from day-one. Reliable patched the boiler and completed the hardware installation of Alerton controls on May 29, 2015. The boiler was placed into a Domestic Hot Water mode with programming to switch over to fully automated winter heating mode for the summer months. On August 28, 2015 our Finance Council identified several installation issues and requested that the remaining contract work be completed. The system failed to automatically switch over to its winter heating mode on Thanksgiving weekend October 12, 2015.

Thanks to your prayer support, Reliable returned on November 4, 2015 to program the system into a winter heating mode. The church is now automatically heated to 20 Deg.C. while the rectory zone valves still require manual intervention twice per night. We continue to wait for Reliable to complete their programming of the Alerton controls, as well as deliver the Alerton building management software.



Church All-Weather Window Project: A contract was awarded on April 16, 2015 to Castle Building Center and Top-Line Construction of Moose Jaw, to install new All-Weather energy efficient windows on the exterior church windows. Top-Line completed the template process for the first half of the windows on July 31st and the remaining windows on August 10, 2015. The templates were sent to All-Weather to be drawn on a computer CAD system as a mechanical design, which was then sent to All-Weather’s manufacturing division.

The first batch of windows were delivered on September 8th and installed by September 30, 2015. During this time, Top-Line and Phili’s Painting also completed the woodwork preparation and painting for the remaining window frames. Breda Brother Builders were commissioned on October 8, 2015 to repair the weather damage to wood frame of the large rose window behind the altar. We are very grateful to the Breda Brothers who did an excellent job of repairing and providing their TLC for the rose window depicting the Blessed Sacrament.

On November 6, 2015 All Weather Windows delivered the second and final batch of windows. Top-Line Construction will be back on site next week to complete their installation of the remaining windows. The installation of two windows will be delayed until structural repairs are completed on the Bell Tower, the adjacent roof and south west church wall.

Call for Refugee Family Volunteers

The Archdiocese of Regina is receiving a new refugee family of five on November 22, 2015. Blessed Sacrament Parish has been asked to consider adopting this family for a period of one year. This means providing 3 - 4 volunteers who are willing to share the responsibilities to help settle and enculturate this family. The volunteers would work together as a team to help the family find an apartment, furniture, food, and clothing; as well as provide transportation to and from naturalization, healthcare, language instruction, schooling, and finding self-sustaining employment.

If 3 - 4 currently registered Blessed Sacrament parishioners are willing to volunteer with a firm commitment for one year, then our finance council will ask to consider the possibility of using parish funds as requested by the Archdiocese.

The volunteers are required to complete all of the Archdiocesan Protocols for this High Security volunteer minister position. At least three (3) committed and dedicated volunteers must come forward by November 18, 2015 to Fr. Barry, Pastor of Blessed Sacrament Parish, before the parish makes any further consideration to take action on this request. Come Holy Spirit
