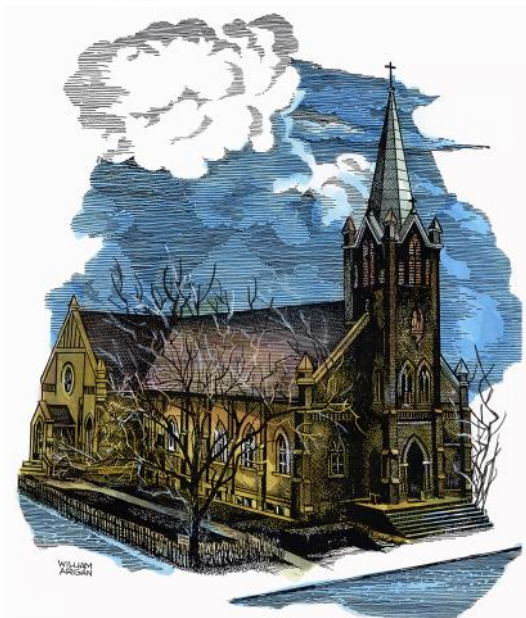


Jesus and the Beloved disciple at the Last Supper

World Youth Day

As you are well aware we have had a number of our youth attend the previous World Youth Days. A number of parents have requested that we include high school age students under the age of 18 in the WYD in January 2019 Panama City, Panama. The diocese on the advice of the CCCB is advising parishes not to support sending youth under age 18 to WYD. This does not preclude parents from taking their own children or organizing a group on their own to take them to WYD. Parents are the primary educators of their children and may choose to participate in any educational event they deem appropriate to support their children's formation. In the event that your parishioners or parish is approached to sponsor a young person under age 18 please understand that the individuals will not be included in diocesan travel insurance or risk mitigation coverage. If families take their youth under age 18 to Panama they do so on their own. This is the prudent action to take on behalf of the diocese.
