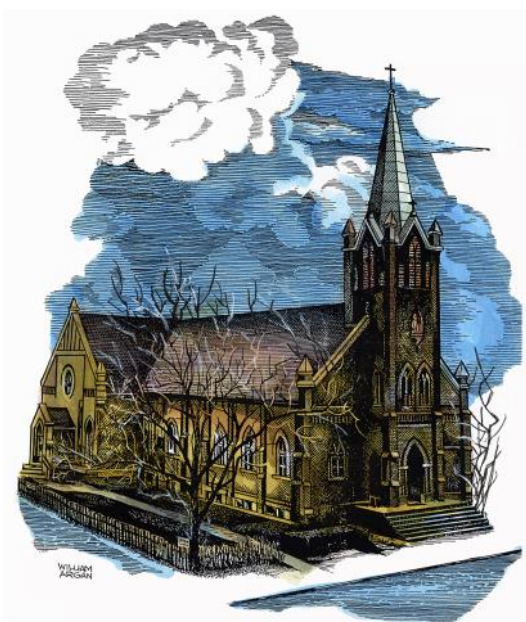


Jesus and the Beloved disciple at the Last Supper

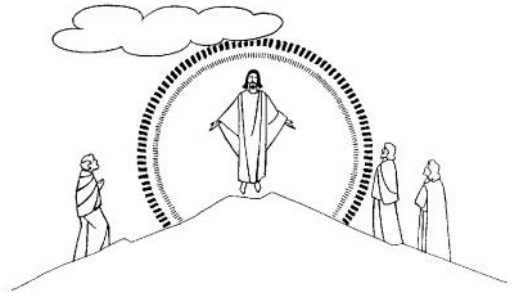
