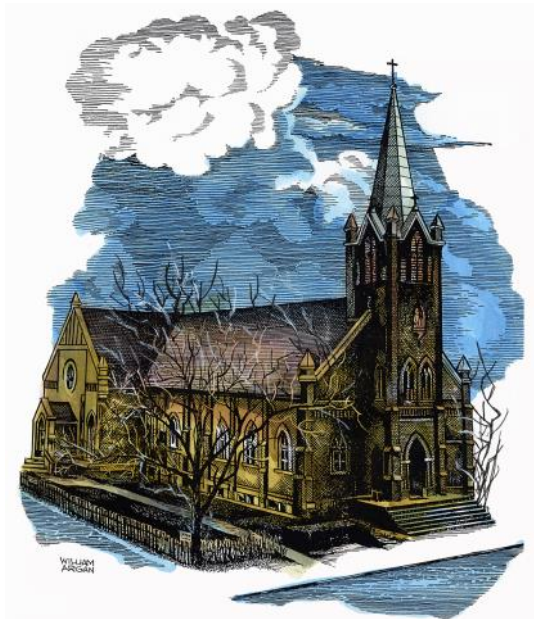

Parish Registration Forms for new parishioners are available at the main entrance of the Church.

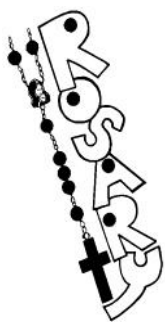
