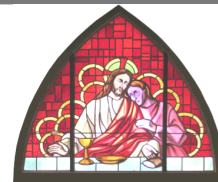

ATTENDING MASS AT OUR CHURCH

• **New SHA Health Order** was announced increasing certain COVID-19 restrictions including **mandatory use of non-medical masks** in all indoor public spaces in Regina. This includes those attending the celebration of the Mass, entering the parish office and attending any other parish gatherings.

• **All persons attending Masses** (including other events or meetings) at Blessed Sacrament Church **are required to wear face masks** from the time they enter our church until they have exited the church.

• **For communion**, people should **leave their mask on** when they come forward, receive communion in the hand, step to the side, slip the mask up, consume the host, replace mask and return to the pew.

• **Arrive** on time so that everyone can be properly social-distanced.

• **Cleaning and Disinfecting** is done immediately before each Mass, and so the doors of the Church open only 30 minutes before each Mass.

Church Visitation: after weekday Masses, Monday to Friday, until 2 PM.

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament: Wednesday, Thursday and Friday after Mass, until 1:00 PM.

BOOK OF REMEMBRANCE

During the month of November, a book will be placed in the church into which you may write the names of your deceased family members and friends. The book will be placed on the altar during Mass and the community will remember them in prayer.

SPECIAL DISINFECTANT FUND

We have been very diligent in preparing and maintaining our parish church in this pandemic. Each day before Mass, our caretaker disinfects the entire area for the congregation in the church. This process involves spraying the pews from a pump spray and then wiping down the pew surface. Additionally, many of you have been using sprayers to wet surfaces and cloths to wipe the surfaces down. This has been a time consuming process, and also some parishioners have raised concerns that this process is damaging the finish on the pews and other wooden surfaces.

We would like to move to equipment for disinfecting and a process which will disinfect-sanitize the church more effectively. For example, we will purchase a handheld battery operated electrostatic ULV sprayer which will disperse a disinfectant which covers the surfaces and kills those airborne viruses. This sprayer not only is for disinfection of the surfaces, but also for purifying the air. We will also move to a disinfectant which will be less damaging to hard surfaces.

To help fund our efforts to disinfect and sanitize the Church and to protect those attending liturgy with all the products we need, we are establishing a "Disinfectant Fund" for the parish.
