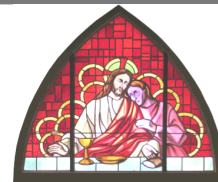

Sacrament of Baptism or Sacraments of Initiation: Please contact the Parish Office for Baptisms during the Easter Season and after.

POPE FRANCIS ON TODAY'S GOSPEL

Gospel according to John 3:14-21

Jesus wept not only for Jerusalem, but for all of us. He gives His life so that we might recognize his visitation. St. Augustine said a word, a very strong sentence: 'I am afraid of God, of Jesus, when He passes!' But why are you afraid? 'I'm afraid I will not recognize Him!' If you are not careful with your heart, you will never know if Jesus is visiting you or not. May the Lord give all of us the grace to recognize the times we have been visited, we are visited and shall be visited, so that we open the door to Jesus and thus ensure that our heart is enlarged ever more by love, and that we might serve the Lord Jesus in love."
